

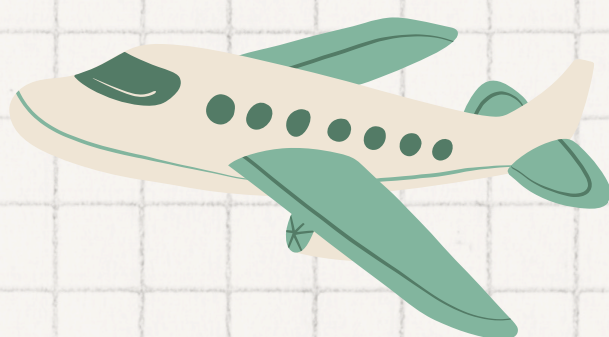
PLANNING FOR A STUDY TRIP TO DUKE DURHAM?

YOUR POINT OF CONTACT AT DUKE DURHAM

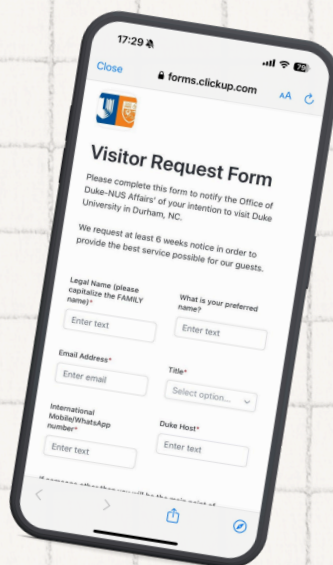
