## Funding Period and Details

- Funding Period will be from 1 November 2023 30 June 2024
- S\$3,000 grant per medical student.
- Supports Other Operating Expenses (OOE) e.g. consumables, research lab tests & reagents etc. and Capital Equipment (CAPEX) e.g. general purpose IT and communication equipment, with approval from JOAM-Academic Programmes Management Department.

 Duke-NUS students undertaking Phase 3 Research / Scholarly projects in July 2023 with a mentor from SingHealth Duke-NUS Academic Clinical Programme (ACP) who is in the list of Duke-NUS Approved Research Mentor.
