#### ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Simulation has offered an exciting array and spectrum of educational training tools and platforms. From the early days of using plastic molds and simple models, we have migrated to high fidelity manikins that can communicate and replicate some physiological functions, a variety of task trainers to practice complex technical skills and many more. The technology in simulation science continues to evolve. One aspect of simulation that can still be potentially expanded and utilised even more is Hybrid Simulation (HS). HS utilises at least two different simulation modalities, whereby combining them will enable one type of simulation modality to enhance the other, with the proper alignment, coordination and inter-facing.

This workshop will explore with participants the definition and use of HS; how it can be utilised and integrated to enhance learners' experience as well as share the multiple current examples of how HS is already being used. This workshop is suitable for both novice as well as more experienced simulation educator. It will be an experiential workshop with hands-on opportunities.
