# **Funding Opportunities – FM ACP Research Seed Grant**

The FM ACP Research Seed Grant aims:

- To support research projects of a lower funding quantum
- To serve as a stepping stone for faculty to generate preliminary data to apply for cluster/national competitive research grants

#### Eligibility

- FM ACP faculty (associate consultants and above) and FM fellowship trainees in BVH, CGH, KKH, SGH, SHP, SKCH and SKH
- Project should be relevant to FM ACP's signature research programmes (SRPs)

#### **Application**

- Open throughout the year till 31 Aug 2019 and submissions will go through a review panel
- Multiple applications can be submitted but each Principal Investigator (PI) will be awarded with only one project

#### Award

S\$10,000 per project for 1 year


