

GILBERT CHIANG SHIH CHUIN BURSARY AWARD

PATHOLOGY ACADEMIC CLINICAL PROGRAMME, SINGHEALTH DUKE-NUS

The **Gilbert Chiang Shih Chuin Bursary** was established in 2019 to support deserving/needy medical students by providing financial assistance for their study expenses. The establishment of the named bursary honours A/Prof Gilbert Chiang's passion in nurturing the younger generation while raising awareness of Pathology as a discipline.

Successful applicants will receive a bursary award of **S\$20,000**.

ELIGIBILITY

- Full-time Singapore Citizen undergraduates (Year 2 to 4) whose monthly per capita household income (PCI)* is **≤\$2,500** or gross monthly household income (GHI)** is **≤\$10,000**.
- **Preference may be accorded to students with an inclination to pursue Pathology as a discipline.**
- Must not concurrently hold any other scholarships, bursaries or prizes/study awards except for the MOE Higher Education Community Bursary/Higher Education Bursary
- Exhibits satisfactory academic performance and professional conduct with no disciplinary record.

APPLICATION

- **Application period:** Open throughout the year

- An application must be accompanied with a copy of his/her CV, academic transcripts and personal statement on his/her medical career aspirations and involvement at the medical school in view of the aspirations.
- Shortlisted applicants may be required to attend interviews conducted by the review panel.
- Successful awardees are required to submit donor appreciation letters and meet the donor(s) (if requested).
- Successful applications will be notified via email.

*PCI: Monthly household per capita income refers to the total gross monthly income of all those living in the household divided by the number of people in the household.

**GHI: Gross monthly household income refers to the total income of all those living in the household.
