WHAT IS GRANT PRE-REVIEW?

It is a holistic suite of reviews by domain experts (scientific and quantitative), designed to preemptively identify gaps and improve the overall quality of a grant prior to submission to a national competitive grant call. It is mandatory for CSA/HCSA*, TA, NIG, first time IRG grant applicants and those who have not previously received a competitive national grant.

Benefits of Grant Pre-Review

1 Increases the chances of winning a national grant



2 Applicants can directly link, and potentially collaborate, with highly experienced partners from Duke University and CQM



3 Portal for scientific and quantitative reviews



4 Promotes SingHealth's reputation by submitting high quality applications



Functions of SingHealth Office of Research (OoR) Pre-Review Secretariat



Information

Ensures all essential information is in order before submission of the proposals for scientific and quantitative reviews, and the return of reviewers' feedback to applicants.



Administrative Support

Provides a full suite of administrative support: From the provision of templates, guidelines and time-line for the collation of project titles, abstracts, full proposal and content check.



Facilitation

Liaison with all stakeholders to facilitate direct and deeper interactions between reviewers and applicants.
