OPERATING A RESEARCH TISSUE BANK

A Research Tissue Bank must be equipped with the following as part of good governance and best practices to ensure safety and to uphold the highest level of compliance.



ACCOUNTABILITY

Establish good governance and monitoring to ensure compliance with regulations and operational sustainability.



INFRASTRUCTURE

Set up adequate infrastructure and adhere to maintenance schedules to ensure quality and safety of biospecimens.



TRAINING

Ensure Tissue Banking personnel are trained and updated regularly on tissue banking regulations and best practices.



PRIVACY AND LAW

Uphold data protection and adhere to agreements to ensure compliance with laws and regulations.



OPERATIONS

Ensure robust biospecimen management through implementation of standard operating procedures.



REPORTING

Ensure all Untoward Occurrence/Serious Adverse Events (SAE) and Suspected Offence or Contravention (SOC) are reported to MOH promptly.
