

Abstract	The Advanced Bioimaging Centre is a research facility within SingHealth Academia. In this talk, I will highlight ABI's capabilities in advanced cellular imaging techniques that will help to address key questions in biology and medicine.
Biography	Dr. Shawn Je is currently an Associate Professor in the Neuroscience and Behavioral Disorders Programme at Duke-NUS Medical School in Singapore. He received his B.S. from KAIST, M.S. from the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, and his Ph.D. in Neuroscience and Genetics from the Graduate Partnership Programme at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) through the George Washington University Medical School. Then, he pursued postdoctoral training at the Howard Hughes Medical Institute (HHMI)/ Duke University Medical School. He joined Duke-NUS Medical School in late 2010 as an Assistant Professor and received his tenure in 2017.
