Tuberculosis : A Forgotten Plague

TB is a global disease, found in every country in the world and is one of the leading infectious cause of death worldwide. Close to one quarter of the world's population are infected with *M.tb*, killing 1.4 million each year. TB significantly impacts socioeconomic development and increase of drug resistance where prevalent. The talk will share some insights from molecular genotyping of Mycobacterium Tuberculosis Complex (MTC) isolates in Singapore, and discuss challenges in TB control.
