Strengthening Spiritual Care Competency: Pearls from Clinical Pastoral Practice

SYNOPSIS

In the United States, Board certified chaplains are well-recognised as spiritual care specialists within the interdisciplinary care team. They undergo rigorous clinical training called "clinical pastoral education" (CPE) to identify and support patients with spiritual distress or unmet spiritual needs.

In this forum, Reverend Baba Carlos Alejandro will share insights from his clinical and supervisory experiences directing various CPE programmes in the United States and Puerto Rico. Using clinical vignettes, Rev. Alejandro will illustrate and discuss common existential and psycho-emotional challenges and issues in spiritual care provision, as well as offer strategies to support both generalist and specialist spiritual care practices.
