How to Improve

Quality of Research?

Implementing a Corrective Action and Preventive Action (CAPA) plan for issues identified during the conduct of research will help to improve quality of research and prevent recurrence of issues.



Corrective Action (CA)

Immediate action(s) taken to eliminate/address/correct a problem that has already occurred or has been identified.

Preventive Action (PA)

Action(s) taken to eliminate the root cause of a potential problem, including the detection or identification of problems, as well as to prevent occurrence and recurrence of existing problems.



EXAMPLE OF CAPA

Issue: Pre-filled dates on Informed Consent Form

IMMEDIATE ACTIONS REQUIRED OF PRINCIPAL INVESTIGATOR (PI)

- Refer to SHS-RSH-ORIC-CWP-201 CAPA Plan for Research on Docupedia
- Perform Root Cause Analysis (RCA) e.g. site staff unaware that ICF should not be pre-filled
- Prepare and implement CAPA Plan



Proposed Corrective Action



Remove all pre-filled information



PI, research participant and/or witness must sign & date personally

Proposed Preventive Action



Put up reminders at common areas



Study Team Training to reinforce
